



Student Travel Awards 2006: Request for Applications

The Ohio Valley Chapter of SETAC is requesting applicants for the OVC Annual Student Travel Awards to help students reduce their cost of attending and presenting their work at the SETAC-NA Annual Meeting in Montreal, Quebec, Canada, November 5-9, 2006.

To apply, please send your abstract *and* confirmation of acceptance (from SETAC-NA) to Joe Schubauer-Berigan (schubauer-berigan.joseph@epa.gov) *and* Dan Petersen (Petersen.Dan@epa.gov) by October 9, 2006. You will receive a confirmation that your application has been received.

Application Procedure:

1. Applicant must be a student member of OVC SETAC by the date of the award. Students may join the OVC SETAC chapter at the time of the travel award application (see the OVC webpage <http://www.setac.org/ohiovalley/joinovc.htm> for membership information).
2. Preference is given to applicants recently active in the Chapter (Masters and Doctoral students are treated equally). After active applicants are served, awards to graduate students who have not previously received an OVC SETAC travel award may be given. All other graduate students who apply, including those who have previously received an OVC SETAC travel award, will be given final preference.
3. Applicant must be the first author for an accepted oral or poster presentation at the upcoming SETAC-NA Annual Meeting.
4. Include a brief description of travel/registration expenses.
5. At least one undergraduate per year may be considered for the travel award.
6. The award amount and number of recipients is determined annually, by vote of the OVC Board of Directors.
