Please join us for the 22nd Annual Meeting of the Rocky Mountain Chapter of the Society of Environmental Toxicology and Chemistry. This meeting will be held in Denver, Colorado at the U.S. EPA Region 8 Headquarters Building in downtown Denver, CO on April 23rd and 24th, 2009.

On Thursday, April 23rd, we will have a half-day workshop with Dr. Dennis Helsel (Practical Stats, www.practicalstats.com) entitled “Interpreting Nondetect Data Correctly”.
