Julie Layschock

Julie Layschock is an environmental analytical chemist and Natural Resources Scientist with the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality's Cleaner Air Oregon program. She has over 20 years of experience in contaminant research and monitoring with previous roles as a tenured Associate Professor of Chemistry at Pacific University, a Fulbright scholar at the University of Porto, a Principal Research Scientist at Battelle Memorial Institute, and a postdoctoral fellow at Los Alamos National Laboratory.



Wayne Landis

Wayne Landis served as Director of the Institute of Environmental Toxicology and Chemistry from September 1989 until December 2021. At West Washington University his research and teaching focused on toxicology, population biology and risk assessment. He is now Research Professor Emeritus and conducting research on the risk assessment of microplastics, contaminants, synthetic biology and on the use of risk assessment to evaluate resource damage and remediation.
